

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2022 Bracken Ridge State School will receive

**\$150,600\***

### This funding will be used to

- Invest in teacher capability development through co-teaching and collaborative curriculum planning cycles that ensure our high quality curriculum planning, assessment and moderation processes are maintained and enhanced.
- Embed our school case management process to focus on precise instruction to support maximum student achievement in English.
- Support each student at risk of not achieving a 'C or above' with tailored support programs.
- Increase the number of students across the school achieving a C (or above) in English to 85% in each year level.
- Increase the number of students achieving an A in English to 20% in each year level.
- Enhance our inclusion model through teacher and teacher aide support provided within classroom settings with a focus on providing co-teaching support and engagement in intentional collaboration.

### Our initiatives include

- Rigorous planning, implementation, moderation and assessment practices of the Australian Curriculum, focused on English.
- Collaborative planning of units of work with a further focus on building assessment capable learners who are supported through precise instruction, differentiated and tailored supports.
- Ongoing implementation of a case management approach to regularly review student progress in English, develop robust action plans that are revisited and reviewed using a collaborative inquiry process (intentional collaboration meetings) multiple times each term to ensure precise instruction and tailored supports meet students' needs (co-teaching).
- Invest in capability of teachers in P-2 through additional purchase of Speech Language therapist to work in partnership with teachers around the evidence based instruction, understanding the elements of learning to read and providing expert, targeted support to students who need it.
